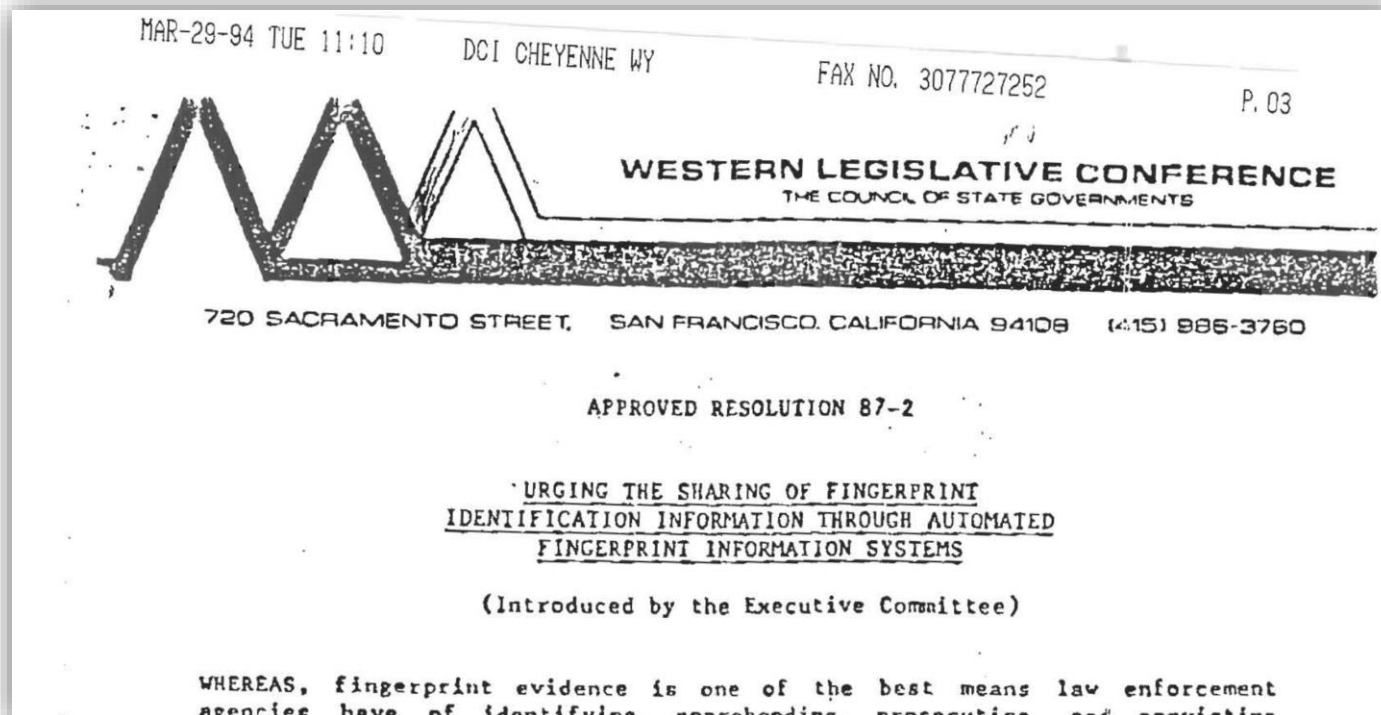

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Nevada, Nev.Rev.Stat. §§ 81.290-.340 (1987), hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

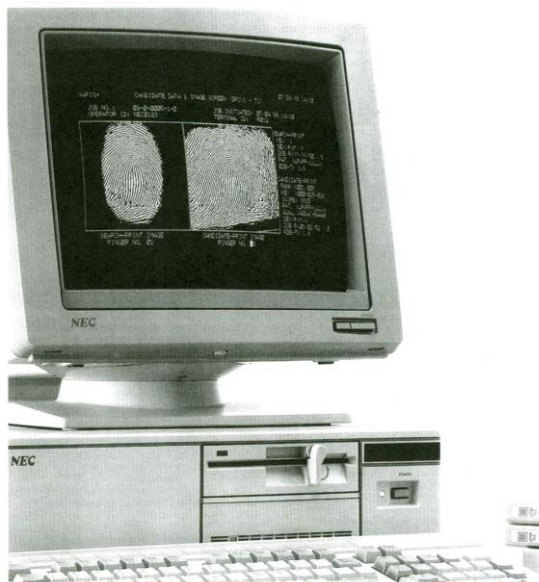

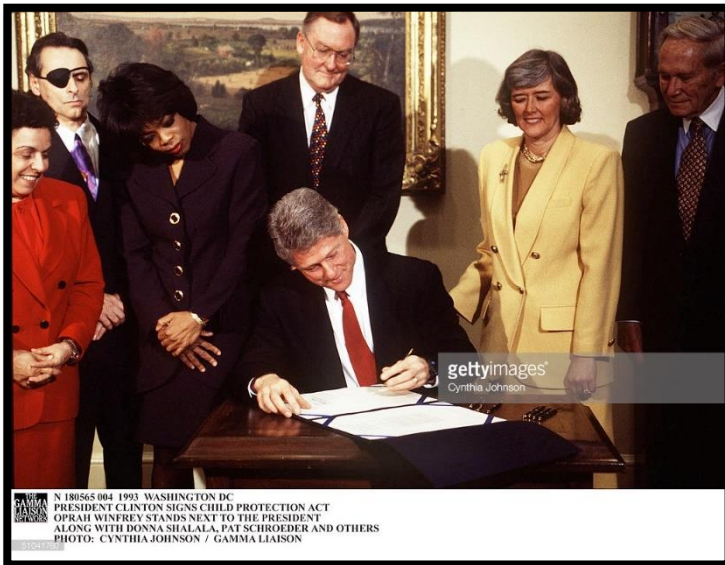

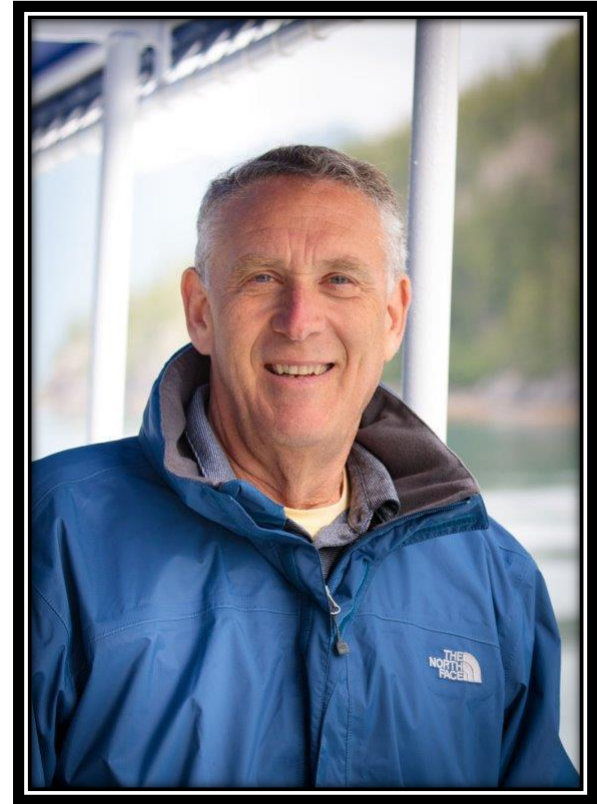
# Middle Years *WIN as of 2001*

- FBI provides national standards and leadership.
  - » Nationwide AFIS network.
  - » New, higher standards service.
  - » National standards for interstate exchange.
- WIN's Year 2000 cost per SID: \$1.12.

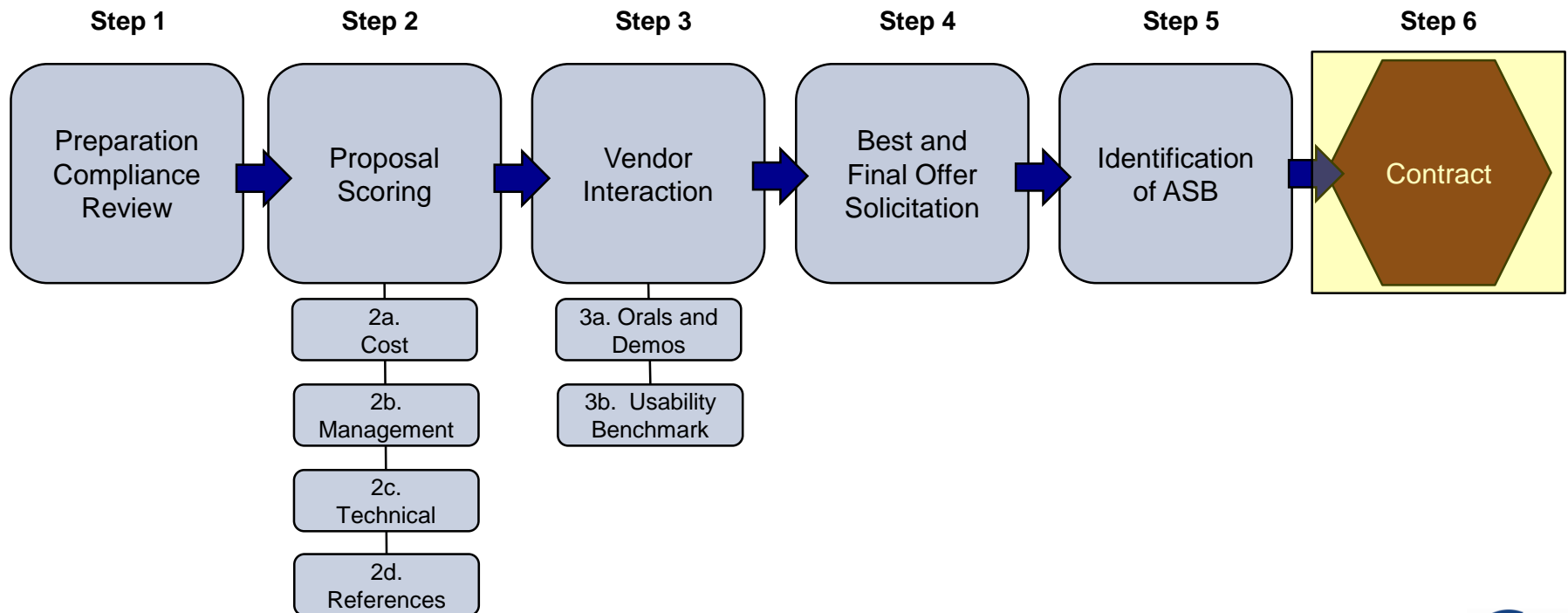
